REFLECTING on a year that tested our organization like no other, two words immediately come to mind: resilience and gratitude.

Like many organizations, we began the year optimistically with the release of safe and effective vaccines, and the hope that the worst of the pandemic was behind us. In retrospect, 2021 proved to be more challenging than any of us could have imagined. New COVID variants caused further strain on our already-stressed healthcare system. Continued public health restrictions resulted in increased anxiety and isolation for our staff, patients, their families, and our grieving community. Vaccine mandates and a national nurse staffing crisis led to unprecedented turnover and an acute shortage of clinical staff which directly impacted our organization. Yet, when our community needed us most, our staff and volunteers remained resilient and unwavering in their commitment to serve the needs of those facing end of life, finding innovative ways to do more with less.

As our organization rebuilds and our clinical team expands, we are reminded that our resilience would not be possible without the continued support of our community. While many nonprofit hospices have closed across Oregon and nationwide, we are deeply grateful for the commitment this community demonstrates to Lumina. Our donors, volunteers, and community partners are the reason we can weather the challenging times and commit to serving the community today and in the years to come.

The work of caring for those who are dying, and their families, is not easy, but it connects and motivates our staff, volunteers, and donors. Lumina's services are simply not possible without our community's collective commitment for which we are profoundly grateful. Together, we look to the future with confidence and hope. •


