AS WE REFLECT on the previous year, we are grateful for the support this community has provided to us for over 40 years. Founded as Benton Hospice Service in 1980, Lumina has built a reputation over the years for providing excellent care to our patients, the families of patients, family caregivers, grieving community members, and the community at large. When I experienced firsthand the incredible care and support provided by Lumina staff and volunteers for my family member, I knew there was no other team I would rather lead. To witness the unwavering dedication of our staff and volunteers during this difficult time was truly inspiring.

Last year we served 335 hospice and palliative care patients. We provided support to 150 family caregivers and distributed 165 activity kits to grieving families and children. We provided 25 patients with basic needs such as bed sheets, toiletries, and groceries. I am proud of the accomplishments and milestones we've made in 2022. As the only independent nonprofit hospice in our service area, we are proud to go above and beyond the basic service requirements many other hospices meet at minimum.

As we look ahead to Lumina's bright future, I am excited to share new innovative programs with our community. The coming years will be some of the most exciting times in Lumina's history. The work we do is not easy, but it is incredibly important. With the support of our community, we will continue to provide compassionate care and support to those in our community facing end of life for many years to come. ✨

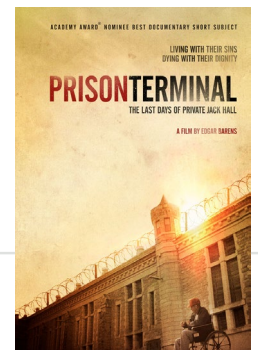
Supporting Youth Who are Grieving

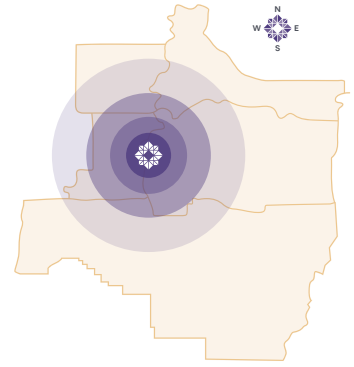
